- Open to any teen working with younger kids as a madrich, guide, student aide, assistant teacher, group leader, counselor, or teen leader in their local Jewish community.
- Participants will learn about creating inclusive learning environments, meaningful experiences for younger kids, stages of child development, behavior management strategies, and fun zoom games. Participants will work with their local Jewish educators to bring learning to life.
