

# URJ MADRICHIM ACADEMY 101

Learn, reflect, and experiment with how to be a student leader in formal, informal, and virtual environments, such as religious school, zoom, youth group, and camp. Collaborate with teens from across North America and educators from your Jewish community to ensure learning is meaningful and relevant.



In Hebrew, *madrachim* means guide or counselor.

Open to **any teen in grade 8-12** working with younger kids as a *madrich*, guide, student aide, assistant teacher, group leader, counselor, or teen leader in their local Jewish community.

Participants learn about being a Jewish Leader, Ages and Stages of Child Development, Multiple Intelligences, and Behavior Management.

Participants work with their local Jewish educators to bring learning to life.

Six 1-hour sessions will be offered virtually Fall 2021.
